#### Brunswick Flushing

Director of Operations Cobb informed the Board the District has begun flushing in Brunswick and will take two to three months to complete.

#### Taylor 50Hp Well

Director of Operations Cobb informed the Board that Taylor Station experienced an unexpected motor failure at Taylor Station on March 11, he contacted DL Maher to make necessary repairs. # Cedar and Hawthorne Main Replacement

District Engineer Schofield informed the Board the bid opening for Cedar and Hawthorne Streets main replacements was held on March 26, with Crooker Construction being the lowest bidder at \$431,987.40. Materials for the project will be provided by the District per project specifications.

# Summer Street Main

District Engineer Schofield informed the Board the District will be installing 8inch ductile iron on Summer Street this construction season. The installation will eliminate two dead ends and keep the main in service during the Frank Wood bridge replacement project.

# Topsham Filtration Facility Update

General Manager Douglas informed the Board construction on the new facility continues to progress well. The Maine Bond Bank and Maine Public Utilities Commission have approved financing for the second year in two \$17.5 million bonds.

Partial Payment Estimate No. 11 for work completed February 16, 2020, through March 16, 2021 in the amount of \$1,168,301.85 was reviewed and has been paid.

### Solar Project
